Tikapaṭṭhāna

Abhidhamma Piṭaka describes the working of the human mind in great detail. Tikapaṭṭhāna is from this piṭaka and explains the twenty-four fundamental relations that govern all phenomena.

Dhamma Cakka Pavattana Sutta

This was the first sermon given by the Buddha to the Pañcavaggiya Bhikkhus. It contains the Buddha's fundamental teaching of the Middle path. The Buddha explains the four noble truths including the noble eightfold path that leads to the complete cessation of suffering.

Gilāna Bojjhaṅga Sutta

On occasions when the Buddha saw that the Elders Kassapa and Moggallāna were sick and suffering, he recited for them the seven factors of enlightenment (bojjhaṅga). Rejoicing at this they were freed from their sickness. Once when the Buddha himself was afflicted by sickness, the Elder Cunda recited it. Having rejoiced at it, the Buddha spontaneously rose up from that illness.
